Pure Single Jamaica Rum – 59%, 700ml



Habitation Velier acts as a dependent bottler: limited releases are done in partnership with distilleries themselves to showcase something unique or special, often outside of the box of the distillery's normal production style. A celebration of 100% pot still rum, Habitation Velier aims to create an appreciation for the depth and character of pot still rum from around the world. All bottles are presented at full (aged) or high (unaged) strength with no filtration or additives.

Deep in the heart of the Lluidas Vale sits Worthy Park Estate, a historic place that has adapted to the times over the past three centuries. Sugar has been produced here from estate-grown sugarcane since 1720 and the first records of rum production date back to 1741. After nearly half a century hiatus from rum making, Worthy Park completed their state of the art distillery in 2005 and again began producing some of the world's best rum. Iconic to Jamaica style, they produce a range of profiles on their copper pot still - the result of quality raw material, fermentation, spring water and careful distillation with nothing else added. Worthy Park remains one of two Jamaican owned distilleries left on the island and the only distillery remaining that produces its own sugar, molasses and rum from its estate-grown sugarcane.

Worthy Park WPL 2007 signifies a batch of the distillery's mark WPL (Worthy Park Light), which denotes an ester level between 60-119 esters per g/hlpa. It was distilled on their iconic double retort pot still built by Forsyths and installed in 2005. It has been bottled at cask strength of 59% after 10 years of aging in the tropical conditions of the distillery in St. Catherine's Parish, Jamaica with no filtration or adulteration.
