Auchentoshan produces the most iconic single malt of the Lowlands. The triple distillation (rare in Scotland) and the distillate's very high alcohol content out of the still enable the production of a fine, subtle, soft and elegant single malt that is often marked by herbal and citrus notes.

Like many legendary single malts, this venerable Auchentoshan shows great complexity and yet remains surprisingly easy to drink.

The intricate aromas and flavors are perfectly balanced to convey the wonderfully rustic character of this revered Lowlands single malt within a remarkably fresh framework.
